

2024 New York State Vineyard Survey

Dear New York Grape Grower,

We need your help to shape the future of New York's grape-growing industry. You know better than anyone how much our industry is evolving. Societal trends, environmental pressures, and shifting market demands are all influencing what and how you grow.

Last year, Deep Planet scans detected **29,586 total vineyard acres** in New York. Growers reported over **15,745 bearing acres**. This next iteration of the vineyard survey will build upon Deep Planet's scans and continue the important process of ground truthing to ensure the most accurate and actionable data for growers like you.

We are committed to serving you better, including advocating for the industry effectively. As the industry's primary resource for research, promotion, and economic development, we rely on up-to-date information to advance initiatives that matter most to growers.

That's why NYWGF, in partnership with **Deep Planet**, **Agency 29**, and **Ag Access**, is continuing the collection of annual vineyard data for New York State. By participating, you'll contribute to a report that:

- **Supports Smarter Planting Decisions:** Help growers make informed choices based on current trends and benchmarks.
- **Strengthens Legislative Support:** Provide the data policymakers need to better advocate for growers, especially during weather-related disasters and other challenges.

Instructions for completing the survey:

Thank you for your participation in this comprehensive statewide survey of grapes grown in 2024 within New York. Your individual responses will be kept confidential and be combined with others to form a summary report. The survey will remain open until May 15, 2025.

- 1. This survey should only be completed by one representative per grower or winery.
- 2. Please provide information for the total acres of grapes you operate in New York. If your vineyard is managed by somebody else, the survey should be completed by that person.

Include your 2024 price per tonnage, new plantings, non-bearing, and bearing (grapes at least two years old) acreage on:

- Land that you own
- Land that you rent from somebody else
- Land that you manage for somebody else

Do not include:

- Land that you rent to somebody else, or somebody else manages for you
- Acres and production originating in another state

- Data from years other than 2024
- 3. Please use a separate line for each variety within each county. For example, if you farm Concord grapes in Cattaraugus and Chautaugua counties, please enter the acreage and tonnage of Concord for each county on two separate lines.
- 4. Please report vineyard acreage only. Do not include headlands, ponds, buildings, etc. Do not include abandoned vineyards that were not farmed in 2024. Please report to the nearest 0.1 acre (one decimal point). If less than 0.1 acres, please do not include.
- 5. If you require further space to complete the survey, please use the provided attachment or include additional pages, as necessary.
- 6. This survey is intended to be a complete census so we need a response from every grower. If you are unable to complete the questionnaire either online or by mailing in your response, please reach out to Gary Scheer for assistance at 314-944-2091 or via email gary.scheer@qlarityaccess.com.
